Our festival will feature non-profit community booths again this year. We ask for a \$30.00 donation to secure your 10x10 booth. Please complete the application below. Once your application has been received and a booth space has been secured, you will receive an email with your confirmation. Event details including booth location will be sent to each vendor one week prior to the event. There are a limited number of booths with electricity, please indicate below IF you would like to be assigned a booth with electrical access. This is NOT a guarantee that you will receive one of these spaces.

For the purpose of this event, a non-profit organization is considered an organization that provides service to members for non-charge or serves in a community organization capacity. An example of approved non-profits would be: church organizations, girl/boy scouts, animal shelter groups, political organizations, etc. An example of organizations that would fall under our patron category would be any type of organization that provides business services such as medical care, insurance, or credit unions. If you would like additional information about becoming a patron, please visit our festival website.

Please note that since many of crafters sell food items and we have vendors designated for food, we will not be allowing any food give away or sales at the non-profit booths. If you would like to do either of these, we will consider you as a crafter and you will need to complete a crafters application.

Volunteers are eligible to receive volunteer hours through the Chesterfield County School system. Please bring any required school documentation for signature.
